

CONNECT Group study questions for May 3rd, 2020

“On Point: Clarity in Uncertain Times” (selected verses from Psalm 119)

Prayer for the Week of May 3rd: This week we are praying that God will use our new interim Pastor, Sonny Holmes, to lead our church into this new season in the life of Crossroads. Pray for Sonny as he preaches the Word to us, that he would be filled with the Spirit and that everyone who hears God’s Word would be obedient to it and grow in their faith in Jesus. Pray for Sonny, the staff, and elders as they make the difficult decisions about how to resume on-campus ministries in the days to come. Also, this month we are praying for the Tanners, missionaries from our church. We’ll be hearing from them and about their prayer needs next week in the service.

1. Over the next five weeks, Pastor Sonny is going to share with us the five Bible passages that have guided his life and ministry. Do you have a “life verse,” a Bible verse or passage that you go back to over and over for guidance and direction in your life and ministry? Share that with the group and tell the story of how and when that verse became so important to you.

2. **Read Psalm 119:105, 37, and 59.** If the Bible really is all of the things Psalm 119 says it is (and we believe that it is!) then why do you think Christians neglect the reading, study, and memorization of the Bible so much? Why do you think Christians neglect proclaiming the Word to a world that desperately needs it?

3. Pastor Sonny picked out three of the dominant images from these three verses: “darkness,” “feet,” and “path.” What are some practical ways, right now, that you and your group can point your collective feet toward the darkness and be a light for the gospel?
