- <u>Deuteronomy 6:6-9.</u> God's Word should be applied all over our lives!
  - <u>Psalm 119:9-16.</u> God's Word makes our ways pure.
  - <u>Psalm 119:28.</u> God's Word strengthens us in difficult times.
  - <u>Matthew 4:4.</u> We LIVE by God's Word.
  - <u>Matthew 7:24-27.</u> If we hear God's Word and act upon it, we build up a firm foundation.
