- 8. Talk with others about it
  - a. Do an honest self-assessment in spending, saving, & giving.
  - Share your self-assessment with a Christian friend and allow them to ask you accountability questions on this topic, such as:
    - What purchase decisions do you most regret?
    - Where are your weaknesses in spending money?
    - How much debt do you have? What is your current plan to get rid of it?
    - How much do you have in savings? Investments? What is the purpose of that money?
    - How much do you give? How much could you give?
  - c. Invite their feedback on how you can be more faithful in honoring God.
  - d. Make a plan and act on it.
