# WHEN SOCIETY SHAKES

"And you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free." - John 8:32

- 1. Open your Bibles and read John 8:32. How has God's Truth set you free? What do you have freedom from?
- 2. John showed evidence that a society that seeks God's Truth becomes a society of freedom. If your family or group of friends were a "society," in what ways are you seeking God's Truth?
- 3. Did you know that the Bible was the foundation for leading universities such as Oxford, Harvard, Princeton, and more? These universities and their graduates produced modern medicine, modern hospitals, the scientific revolution, Western democracy, and even our basic ability to read (literacy and public education). Discuss what our lives would look like today without these advances made by Christians.
- 4. Just as homeowners prepare for a hurricane, we are preparing spiritually for the cultural storms that will occur in our lifetime. We have summarized our preparation in the "9 Manifestos." Take a moment to read these aloud (see page 3). Which manifestos stand out to you?
- 5. Let's focus on Manifesto 1. "We will remain rooted to the Christian scriptures." Take a moment to read Psalm 119:30. Is the Word of God your standard for what you do and believe? Where do you struggle to take the Word of God as your standard?
- 6. On a scale of 1 to 10, how much of your worldview is based on culture versus Scripture (with 1 being fully shaped by culture and 10 being fully shaped by Scripture)? What are some ways you could raise your number?
- 7. Now let's talk about Manifesto 2. "We will train our young." Have you thought about how your kids and grandkids are being taught to see the world? Do you think our young people's view of the world is more influenced by scripture or culture?

8. Casual or intentional? Which one of these words best describes your weekly effort to see reality according to God's Word. Which word best describes your effort to help your spouse, children, or grandchildren see reality through the lens of God's Word?
