JESUS, THE ONE TRUE GOD

BIG IDEA

What do we mean when we say Jesus?

Who do you believe Jesus is?

SCRIPTURE

Peter's answer about who Jesus is in Matthew 16:13-17 is loaded with meaning: 1) the Christ is the Messiah (who people are looking for) and 2) the Son of the living God (that the God in heaven is now here on earth with us). Reflect on this passage.

QUESTIONS

- Take a moment to review the "Jesus Loves Me" summary card on pages 3 and 4 of this study guide. This week we are studying the word *JESUS*. Was there an idea under this word that surprised you, encouraged you, or that you're not sure you agree with?
- What do we need to believe about Jesus to actually access the power of God? Are there things that are keeping you from believing those things?
- How did you access the power of God this last week? How did it feel?
- What are some of the definitions you've heard from others about who Jesus is?
- What have you turned to in your life to try to make you happy and/or fill a void?
- Who do you believe Jesus to be? What parts of this are hard for you to wrap your mind around?
- Do you fear death? Why? In what ways?

QUESTIONS (CONTINUED)

- What part of Christ's being fully human are you most thankful for or do you relate to the most?
- What part of Christ being fully God are you most thankful for?
- What are some common errors that people believe about Jesus?

TAKEAWAY

If a belief doesn't hold that Jesus is the one true God, then it's not Christianity, and it won't have the power of God that brings salvation. It is a life or death issue that we need to be clear about. Have you decided what you believe?
