QUESTIONS

1. What illustration, scripture or story was especially impactful for you this week?
2. Pastor John shared a number of different ways God is working this Christmas season. Where are you most excited to see God work in your life and community over the coming weeks?
3. What enemy stands in the way of a “merry” Christmas for you? Where are you struggling to find peace, joy, or comfort? How is God providing His peace, joy and comfort to you in this particular struggle?
4. In 1 Samuel 17, young David fights and defeats Goliath. God had been preparing David for this battle for years by having David practice being in His presence. Where in your life have you seen God preparing you for battle against your giants in life?
5. Read 1 Corinthians 1:28. How does God use things “despised by the world” to do His work still today?
6. In Luke 1:28, it says, “Greetings, you who are highly favored! The Lord is with you.” Mary heard this for what was true for her life and what is true for us. The Lord is with us. In what ways can you sense God is with you? How can you continue to practice the presence of God that Pastor John shared with us?
