1. What illustration, story or example stood out to you this week?
2. What has you most excited about the next generation of Jesus followers?
3. Read Proverbs 22:6. In what ways did people invest in your spiritual life when you were a child? How can you invest in the next generation?
4. Read Exodus 1:15-17. Pastor John reminds us about the courage of the Hebrew midwives in defying Pharaoh's orders. When did you have to be courageous in your faith? Where do you need to step out and be more courageous in your faith (in relationships with others, in your future, in your time, in your finances?)
