4. How can you live with a holy expectation where you are looking for God to show up in the circumstances around you, like Moses seeing the burning bush?
5. Read Exodus 3:6. How does it make you feel when you think about God being eternal and holy, but also being so close and humble?
6. Read Galatians 5:16-18. How do you let the Holy Spirit guide your life?
