Questions

1. What illustration, story, or example stood out to you this week?

4. When have you shared your faith with a non-believer? Share with the group how you felt, how it went, and what are the results that you have seen from that conversation so far?
5. What (if anything) intimidates you about sharing your faith? What steps can you take to address those concerns? Are you asking God to be with you in those conversations?
6. "Our mission from God is not to get people to agree with us. Our mission is to get people to Jesus." How does shifting your goal from agreement to meeting Jesus also shift your approach to non-believers?
7. What one practical step do you plan to implement from this week's message?
