WEEK 6: Weren't These Things Meant to Be?

INTRODUCTION & OPENING QUESTION

In the Bible, wherever Jesus spoke, his words are highlighted in **RED**. Throughout this series, we are looking at some of the questions that Jesus asked of the people around him, and we will learn some life-changing truths from those red letters. This Easter we look at the question Jesus asked in Luke 24, "Weren't these things meant to be?"

Share a memorable Easter memory, or tradition, that has impacted you!

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Instructions for the group meeting: Read each question out loud and give ample time for discussion. Then read through any Bible references for additional discussion and context. Close out the evening in prayer.

Read Luke 24:13-35 out loud to the group before starting the questions.

- 1) **How does the resurrection of Jesus bring you hope today?**
- 2) **Have you ever felt like God was the only one who didn't know what was happening in your life? Or that He was especially distant? If yes, please share.**
- 3) **Share a time when you expected God to act a certain way, and it seemed like He didn't.**
- 4) **In verse 17, Jesus asked the two followers, "what are you discussing so intently?" How does it make you feel to know that Jesus wants to know your story?**
- 5) **We learned three truths this weekend. Which of them is most encouraging to you?**
 - Nothing catches God by surprise.
 - Nothing can stop God from loving US. Romans 8:31-39
 - Nothing gets in the way of God's plans.
- 6) **Is there anything else that stood out to you from the message?**
