INTRODUCTION & OPENING QUESTION

There are so many opinions in this world about what we should be living our lives for or how we should be defining ourselves. - 3) God created you with a unique set of gifts. What do you think those are, and how can you use them to serve Him and others?
- 4) Following Jesus has its challenges. Our enemy will do anything to stop or discourage us. Have you ever been frustrated, serving, and wanted to quit? If so, did you, and why? If not, what motivated you to keep going?
- 5) In Luke 5, The four men who helped their paralyzed friend created others' opportunity to witness remarkable things. When we love others by serving them, we can prepare for miracles to happen. How does their story inspire and motivate you to take action to help those around you?
