INTRODUCTION

"For I know that plans I have for you," says the Lord. "They are plans for good and not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope." Jeremiah 29:11

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

4. Pastor Mark said, *"God will orchestrate, but we have to cooperate!"* What, in your opinion, is cooperation with God?
5. Have you ever made mistakes because you wouldn't stop worrying about a situation? Share your thoughts about the following statement, *"If it's big enough to worry about, it's the right size to pray about!"*
6. Have you ever viewed your opposition as more significant than God? How did it impact the way you navigated your circumstances?
7. Read Isaiah 7:9. What do you think about God's statement to King Ahaz?
8. What was your biggest takeaway from the message, and why?
