INTRODUCTION

"For I know that plans I have for you," says the Lord. "They are plans for good and not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope." Jeremiah 29:11

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Read Jeremiah 29:11 and Romans 8:28. Can you testify that God had made way for you in times when there seemed to be no way? Then, share some testimonies of how these Scriptures have been true in your life.
2. What if God's best plans for you don't happen in this life? Would you really want God's best in this world now? Would you really want your best life now, seeing you'd have to have it in such a broken, temporary world? Would you be OK if God's best is reserved for the next life?
3. Do you ever get the feeling that you weren't built for this world? Do you ever get the feeling that you are being prepared for a better world? Read 2 Corinthians 5:4-5. Do these verses affirm those feelings? If so, why?
4. Read 1 Thessalonians 4:15-18. Do you believe you are ready for Jesus' return? Why do you feel you are ready? If not, what do you think you need to do to be prepared?
5. What was your biggest takeaway from the message, and why?
6. What has been your biggest takeaway from this series, and why?
