## THE HALL OF FAITH

### STARTING POINT

**Who do you know that has strong faith?  
How can we remain faithful to God?**

Parent Helps (PH): Starting Point is designed as a conversation starter. This section allows you to introduce big concepts in simple questions.

### TRUE NORTH

**Hebrews 11**

PH: The True North section is designed to point us to God's Word. This section allows you to disciple your family by opening the Bible together.

### TRAIL MARKERS

PH: Trail Markers are designed to get your family talking about important issues. This section allows you to see what your family thinks and believes about who God is.

**1. What is faith? What trait tied all the Old Testament heroes together?**

PH: Faith is being sure that what we hope for will happen. Read Hebrews 11:1. The Old Testament heroes were tied together by their faith. See all of Hebrews 11.

**2. Are faithful people rewarded with happy, easy lives? What is the reward God gives for faith?**

PH: No, having faith is not always easy. Read Hebrews 11:36-37. Most often, God's rewards are bigger than material possessions, fame, glory, or power. Instead, God promises eternal life with Him in the perfect world Jesus will bring when He returns.

**3. How can you put your faith in action?**

PH: We need to understand that sometimes it is hard to have faith. We don't have to have faith in our own strength. Ask God to give you faith. Encourage your kids to look for ways they can trust and obey God with whatever is happening in their lives right now. God can work mightily through people who have faith in Him.

### END POINT

PH: God kept his promises to send the Messiah – His own Son, Jesus – to rescue people from sin. Jesus is the true hero of the Bible. He gives us faith. We can look to Him because in Him, all of God's promises will come true.
