STARTING POINT

- ✈️ How can we pray for people in need?
Who can we pray for?

Parent Helps (PH): Starting Point is designed as a conversation starter. This section allows you to introduce big concepts in simple questions.

TRUE NORTH

Acts 12

PH: The True North section is designed to point us to God's Word. This section allows you to disciple your family by opening the Bible together.

TRAIL MARKERS

PH: Trail Markers are designed to get your family talking about important issues. This section allows you to see what your family thinks and believes about who God is.

1. Why was Peter arrested and in prison?

PH: King Herod was persecuting Christians. Read Acts 12:1-4. Herod had killed Jesus' half-brother, James. King Herod saw that the Jews were pleased so he also arrested Peter and put him in prison.

2. How did the church respond to Peter's imprisonment?

Do you pray big prayers?

PH: The church responded by praying for Peter. Read Acts 12:5. Sometimes praying might not seem like much but remember Who we pray to. God hears and answers prayers. He may not always answer in the way we expect, but He always does what is for His glory and our good.

3. What are ways God can use our hard times to bless us and glorify Himself?

PH: Think about the qualities God may develop in us through trials, such as patience, endurance, and compassion for others who are suffering. Think about the importance of trusting God's plans even when life is scary or difficult.

END POINT

PH: God answered the people's prayers for Peter. God had a plan for Peter and the church, and He rescued Peter from his enemies. Peter knew he would face death because he believed in Jesus, but he kept going so he could share the good news of the gospel.
