PAUL'S FIRST JOURNEY

STARTING POINT

 Talk about a time that you went on a “journey” with your family.

Parent Helps (PH): Starting Point is designed as a conversation starter. This section allows you to introduce big concepts in simple questions.

TRUE NORTH

Acts 14:8-23 (Further Reading: Acts 13-14)

PH: The True North section is designed to point us to God's Word. This section allows you to disciple your family by opening the Bible together.

TRAIL MARKERS

PH: Trail Markers are designed to get your family talking about important issues. This section allows you to see what your family thinks and believes about who God is.

1. Why were Paul and Barnabas on a journey?

PH: They wanted to share the good news about Jesus with people. There are still people all over the world who have not heard about Jesus (some of them may even live next door to you).

2. Do you know anyone with a nickname?

PH: In the book of Acts you will sometimes read about a man named Paul and at other times you will read about a man named Saul, but they are the same person. Paul is his Roman name and Saul is his Jewish name.

3. Was Paul accepted by everyone?

PH: Paul used different names with different groups of people to try to be all things to all people for the sake of the gospel (1 Cor 9:19-23) yet people still rejected him. Many people will reject you because you love Jesus too, but we have a church family that will love and support us.

END POINT

PH: Many people rejected the good news about Jesus, but God had a plan for Paul to share the gospel with Gentiles, no matter what troubles he faced. Many believed in Jesus. The church grew and the gospel spread so that people all over the world could be saved from their sin by trusting in Jesus.
