THE CHURCH DIVIDED

STARTING POINT

Who are some people you struggle to get along with?
How can you show love to those people?

Parent Helps (PH): Starting Point is designed as a conversation starter. This section allows you to introduce big concepts in simple questions.

TRUE NORTH

1 Corinthians 1-6

PH: The True North section is designed to point us to God's Word. This section allows you to disciple your family by opening the Bible together.

TRAIL MARKERS

PH: Trail Markers are designed to get your family talking about important issues. This section allows you to see what your family thinks and believes about who God is.

1. What was one of the main disagreements in the Corinthian church that Paul addressed?

PH: The people in the church at Corinth were divided. They formed groups based on who they thought was the best teacher: Paul, Apollos, Peter, or Jesus. Read 1 Corinthians 1:12

2. What does it mean to boast in the Lord?

PH: Always think about God as the source of every good thing we have. All our gifts and talents come from God. Our salvation comes from God. All wisdom comes from God. We cannot boast unless we are boasting in what God is doing.

3. Does being united in Christ mean we have to agree on everything?

PH: We don't have to agree on everything. But there are some things that are essential for Christians to agree on – like Jesus's death and resurrection and the fact that we are saved by grace alone, through faith alone. Believers will disagree about some things, but the way in which we disagree ought to still be marked by Christ's love.

END POINT

PH: Paul told the believers in the Corinthian church to come together because of the gospel. He reminded them that Jesus saves sinners. Because of Jesus and what He has done, believers can humbly come together as one body.
