**Theme:** A Joy-Centered Life is a Gospel-Centered Life (1:12-18).

- 1. A Gospel-Centered Life Sees Pain as Providential (1:12-13).
  - **Genesis 50:20,** "As for you, you meant evil against me, but God meant it for good, to bring it about that many people should be kept alive, as they are today.
  - **Job 1:21,** "The Lord gave, and the Lord has taken away; blessed be the name of the Lord."
  - Acts 2:23-24, "This Jesus, delivered up according to the definite plan and foreknowledge of God, you crucified and killed by the hands of lawless men.
- 2. A Gospel-Centered Life Sees Fear as Unfounded (1:14).
  - Psalm 56:3-4, "When I am afraid, I put my trust in you. In God, whose word I praise, in God I trust; I shall not be afraid. What can flesh do to me?"
  - Luke 12:4-5, "I tell you, my friends, do not fear those who kill the body, and after that have nothing more that they can do. But I will warn you whom to fear: fear him who, after he was killed, has authority to cast into hell."
- 3. A Gospel-Centered Life Sees **Esteem** as **Expendable** (1:15-18).
  - Psalm 115:1, "Not to us, O Lord, not to us, but to your name give glory, for the sake of your steadfast love and your faithfulness!"
