- 1037-1010 BC: King Saul's Reign
- 1010-931 BC: Davidic Monarchy (1 Chron 10-2 Chron 9)
 - David (1010 BC to 970 BC)
 - Solomon (970 BC - 931 BC)
- 931-586 BC: Division of Kingdom and Down spiraling of Israel/Judah
- 605 BC: Babylonian Campaign Against Judah begins under Nebuchadnezzar
- 586 BC: Destruction of the Temple and Deportation of many to Babylon
- 538 BC: Edict of Cyrus
 - Babylon Falls to Persia under Cyrus II
 - Priests and Civil leaders can go back to Judah
- 516 BC: Temple completely rebuilt
- 458 BC: Ezra restores the Law
- 445 BC: Nehemiah rebuilds the walls of Jerusalem in 52 days
