- Bible Study Can Seem Irrelevant "It's not practical"
- Bible Study Can Seem Inaccessible "I'm not smart enough"
- Bible Study Can Seem Unnecessary "It's not my job"
- Bible Study Can Seem Unimportant "I don't have time"
- Bible Study Can Seem Unreliable "I have my doubts"

Understanding the Bible is Required: (2 Timothy 2:15):

• Bible Students Must Be Faithful - "workman" (ergates - "a laborer")

• Bible Students Must Be Committed - "do your best" (spoudazo - "be diligent with haste")

• Bible Students Must Be Careful – "rightly handling" (orthotomeo – "cutting a straight path")

• Bible Students Must Be Accountable - "one approved" (dokizamo - "testing to approve")
