2. The Trinity is Life, Truth, and Love

3. Man is sinless and divine.

4.	Sin is an illusion, along with sickness and death.
5.	Jesus was a mere human who rescues from this illusion.
6.	Christ is the divine truth embodied by the human Jesus.
7.	The Cross did not atone for sins but demonstrated goodness.
8.	Salvation involves ceasing to believe in illusions.
