 - o In the **English Reformation** with the **Puritans** (c. 1700's)?
- 2. Roots: Began as English Separatists Purifying Puritanism
 - Church Membership Must Be Believers Baptized by Immersion
 - Church Polity Must Be Congregational
 - Church Government Must Be Autonomous



- 3. Shoots: The Rise of English Baptists
 - Began Covenanting Together with Membership
 - Began Cooperating Together with Associations and Conventions
 - Began Confessing Together with Confessions of Faith
 - Began Evangelizing Together with Missionary Organizations
- **4. Fruits:** The Rise of Baptist Denominations in America
 - For Theological Reasons: General Baptists and Particular Baptists
 - For Historical Reasons: Landmark Baptists
 - For Political Reasons: Southern Baptists and Northern Baptists (American Baptists, USA)
