The Gospel in Romans Week 4 - Clarity Romans 3:21-26

Introduction

Before answering the following questions, the best thing to do is read Romans chapter 1, 2 and 3:1-20. And then read 3:21-26.

Questions for Study

1. Write a 3 to 4 sentence summary of what you learn about mankind from what you've read in Romans 1:18 through 3:20.

- 2. If this was all that Paul wrote, what would be your conclusion about your potential for a relationship with God from reading these (63) verses?
- 3. Why is it so important for all of us that Paul wrote what he did in these (63) verses?

Read Romans 3:21-26 a second time. (Better yet, several more times.) And then answer the following two questions:

- 4. What are the key words in these verses? What does each word mean?
- 5. How can you use Romans 3:21-26 to explain the gospel to another person? (Write out what you would say using these verses.)

The book of Romans is brilliant apologetic for the Christian faith. Know this book well and it will equip you to share your faith in Christ. The title for this series is taken from Paul's personal declaration of confidence in the gospel.
