Week 4 | Walking With God Psalm 15

Read Psalm 15 before answering the following questions.

Introduction

We all have dreams for our lives. The key thing is to keep dreaming those dreams and do it on the basis of who God is and our relationship with him. This week's sermon focuses on what it takes to walk in unhindered fellowship with God.

Questions for Study

- 1. Write down your definition of integrity.
- 2. Why is integrity so important?
- 3. David asks a question in the first verse of Psalm 15. Write it in your own words. What's he asking?

David answers his question verses 2-5. The first phrase in verse 2 - He whose walk is blameless – points to integrity. Each phrase that follows unpacks what's true of a person who lives a life of integrity.

- 4. Write down each phrase and answer why it's an indicator of integrity. (Write answer on back.)
- 5. What does the last statement in this psalm say is true of someone who lives a life of integrity? Why do you think this is true?
- 6. What do your actions say that your integrity is worth to you? (Give this question careful thought before answering.)
