Mark 10:35-45

Introduction: For all intents and purposes, January is the month for self-improvement. It's a time to reflect, refocus, and restart. Because of this, the new year is typically a season of self-absorption. It's all about what we can do to make ourselves better people. The result is that churches, health clubs, debt counselors, and vitamin shops do a booming business. But what if we asked ourselves a better question. Rather than ask, "What needs to be done about me?", what if we asked, "What needs to be done around me?" But there's a cost to that question. What if we don't want to give up some "life"? But, as we'll see, Jesus said that the only way to live a life of purpose and meaning is to give our lives away.

Discussion Questions:

- 1. Have you set any New Year's resolutions this year? If so, what are they?
- 2. Why do you think New Year's resolutions don't typically stick for most people?
- 3. How would you define "greatness"?
- 4. When it comes to "getting to the top" in this world, what's the "upside down" rule of greatness in the Kingdom of God according to Mark 10:42-44? Do you believe this is true?
- 5. Have someone read Mark 10:45. How did Jesus come to "ransom" us? What does that mean for us?
- 6. How much did God pay to "buy us back" as it were? Should that change our perspective on giving ourselves to serve others?
- 7. Why can "being a servant" sometimes be hard in our world today?
- 8. How can we look at servanthood with dignity, respect, and even excitement, more than with grumpiness?
- 9. **NEXT STEP:** What breaks your heart? What needs to change in your community? What can you do? Who can you partner with? Jesus invites you to a life of purpose. Among your other New Year's resolutions, devote yourself to serving others more in 2017.
