Questions for Study and Group Discussion

- 1. Go around the group and introduce something about yourself that the rest of the group may not know.
- 2. Why is the way we identify ourselves important? What difference does the way we view ourselves make?
- 3. How does identity (the way we view ourselves) influence our purpose (the things we do and what we're about)?
- 4. Read 1 Peter 2:9-10. What stands out to you about the way Christians are identified in these verses? Share a handful of key observations from this passage.
- 5. Read the following verses. After reading reach, share what they say about a Christian's identity in Christ AND why this is significant.
 - Matthew 5:13-14
 - John 1:12
 - John 15:15
 - Romans 8:1
 - 2 Corinthians 5:17
 - Galatians 4:6-7
- 6. Why is your identity in Christ worth fighting for? What happens if we DON'T fight for this?
- 7. What are the biggest challenges to fighting for (and living out of) your identity in Christ? Work as a group to identify at least 4-5 challenges.
- 8. Which of these challenges have you faced personally, as you think about living in line with your identity in Christ? How were these challenges handled?
- 9. What practical steps do you need to take this week to live in line with your identity in Christ? How can you help each other with this as a group?
