Questions for Study

- 1. Spend some time sharing any notable Father's Day memories maybe something you did for your dad growing up, ways you're spending Father's Day this year, etc.
- 2. Why is it important to celebrate dads and acknowledge their influence?
- 3. In the Old Testament book of Esther, we meet someone named Mordecai who consistently shines as an example of a godly man who makes a positive impact. Read Esther 2:5-7, then answer the following questions:
 - What important background information do these verses give us on Mordecai?
 - What insights does this give about Mordecai's character?
 - Even though Mordecai wasn't Esther's biological dad, he was a father figure in her life. Why is having a father figure important? If you're a guy, to whom can you be a godly father figure?
- 4. We learn a lot more about Mordecai as the story of Esther continues. Read the following passages. After each, summarize what they tell us about Mordecai in a word or short phrase.
 - Esther 2:11
 - Esther 2:20
 - Esther 3:1-4
 - Esther 4:6-17
 - Esther 9:20-23
 - Esther 10:1-3
- 5. Choose one of the "take-aways" from Mordecai's life, based on what you observed in the previous question. How can you grow in and model this quality in your own life?
- 6. Share other examples from your own life about ways godly men have made a big difference in your life, or the lives of others you know. Get specific in mentioning what stands out to you from their example, and positive ways they've made a difference in who you are today.
- 7. What can you do this week to encourage a "godly guy" in your life, and say "thanks" for his positive influence on you?
