

## **Leadership Development**

Discussion Guide November 24, 2019 John 13:1-17

## **Questions for Study and Discussion**

\*\*Before you begin, please read John 13:1-17 as a group.

- 1. Name a leader in your life who influenced you in a big way. Describe their leadership. How did they develop you?
- 2. In what ways are you a leader? If you don't see yourself as a leader, how does answering this question help you see the influence you can have: "What difference can you make in the life of someone else, that no one else can?"
- 3. Why can leadership development be ignored or overlooked in churches? Why is leadership development important for churches to be intentional about?
- 4. Read the following passages. How does each one add something to the place that leadership development has in Christianity?
  - Romans 12:4-8 (look especially at verse 8)
- 2 Timothy 2:2

- Ephesians 4:11-12
- 5. Reflect on John 13:1-5. How does this section establish the authority and power (the leadership!) of Jesus?
- 6. How does Jesus' ultimate authority express itself in verses 4-5? What surprises you about this?
- 7. True leadership is expressed in humble service. How does this challenge other notions of power and authority in our culture?
- 8. Now focus on John 13:12-17. What command does Jesus give His followers here?
- 9. As we value leadership development, what does John 13:1-17 say about the kind of leaders we want to develop (and the kind of leaders we want to be)?
- 10. In whatever ways you can influence others (in big ways or small ways), how can you show humble service? (Get specific in your responses!)
- 11. What we learn in John 13 drives how we value the importance of "Leadership Development" as a church. What are we already doing as a church family to embody this value? Are there ways we can continue to grow in this value as a community of Christ-followers?
- 12. In what ways can you embody this value personally in your life? What can this look like in your life this coming week?
- 13. **Challenge: Memorize John 13:14-15:** "14 Now that I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also should wash one another's feet. 15 I have set you an example that you should do as I have done for you."
