Questions for Study and Discussion

** Before you begin, please read Mark 1:32-35 as a group.

- 1. As we head into the New Year, what priorities do you want to shape your life moving forward? Why?
- 2. Look at the larger context in which Mark 1:32-35 sits. From Mark 1:29-39, what priorities of Jesus emerge? Make a list of Jesus' priorities in this passage.
- 3. Now focus in on Jesus' priority of prayer. From what you've read in Mark 1, how is it evident that Jesus makes prayer a priority in His life?
- 4. Read the following passages. After each, share how it sheds additional light on the practice of prayer in Jesus' life:
 - Luke 5:16
 - Luke 6:12-16
 - Matthew 14:15-21 (esp. v. 19)
 - John 11:38-44
 - Matthew 26:36-44
- 5. Why is it significant that Jesus prioritized prayer? What does this mean for your own life, as a follower of Jesus?
- 6. Why is developing and growing in the habit of prayer important for followers of Jesus? How does prayer form us?
- 7. Share about your own experience with prayer. Does prayer come naturally for you, or is it more difficult? Why?
- 8. What practical tips have you found helpful for cultivating your prayer life?
