SERMON APPLICATION GUIDE

JOHN 12:36b-50

DISCUSSION 1: Fulfilled Unbelief (vs.36b-41)

- 1. What are some popular reasons people do not believe in Jesus today? What are some reasons that were difficult for you to believe before you placed your faith in Jesus?
- 2. What is unbelief? What are people really saying when they say they don't believe in Jesus? How is unbelief different from indecision? Did the people in our passage have a lack of understanding of who Jesus was or lack understanding of his power and message? How does this help us understand the nature of unbelief?
- 3. What prophecies were fulfilled in this section? What is your initial response to these verses quoted in Isaiah? What questions or objections come to your mind?
- 4. **Read Isaiah 6:1-13.** How does the context of this passage help us understand who God is and how it relates to the greater themes in the book of John?
- 5. What was the explanation John gives for Isaiah's inspiration (vs41)? How does God's glory relate to our belief or unbelief?
- 6. Should we stop evangelizing because God says that some *could not believe?* Why or Why not?

DISCUSSION 2: Fearful Unbelief (vs. 42-43)

- 1. Read Romans 10:9-13. According to these verses, what is necessary to be saved?
- 2. In our passage, what were the authorities fearful of that kept them from confessing Jesus? Do you think that these people truly believed in Jesus? Why or why not?
- 3. How does the fear of man tempt us to act as if we don't believe in Jesus? What do we need to believe to combat this temptation?

DISCUSSION 3: Faith-filled Belief (vs. 44-50)

- 1. What does Jesus promise to those who believe? How does true faith manifest itself in a believe? What ought we to do when we fail to live out what we believe?
- 2. How can we as a church help one another hear the words of Christ and keep them?
- 3. How ought the coming judgement from God the Father motivate us to tell the gospel to our neighbors, friends and families?

FAMILY DISCIPLESHIP QUESTIONS

- 1. What does it mean to believe in Jesus? What do we believe Jesus did for us?
- 2. Who gives us the ability to believe in Jesus?
- 3. Who do you know today that doesn't believe in Jesus? Pray to God, with your family, that God would give him or her a heart to believe.
