Ice Breaker: Is there an item in your home on display that would not mean much to a guest but has a deep story or significance to you?

Ice Breaker: How have you seen God's goodness to you this week?

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

- 1. Context: What has happened in the passage immediately prior to our text?
- 2. In this section, we read about how Solomon furnished the temple. What are some of your observations of this text? What items seem to have high importance?
- 3. What purpose did the water carts serve in the temple? Why do New Testament Christians no longer adhere to ritual cleansings? How does someone become "clean" today?
- 4. All of these temple items have a story and a meaning behind them connected to a liturgy of worship. What is a liturgy and where do we see them today? Are liturgies helpful? Why or why not? Why is important to examine the liturgy of your life?
- 5. What does the liturgy of your own life teach those around you? What does your family liturgy say you value most?
- 6. What is the liturgy of our church? What do we teach we value most?
- 7. Why do all these details matter to us today? Why is it important to spend time on the details of our own life especially in your walk with the Lord?
- 8. We see that Solomon finished the task God have him to do in vs. 51. Is there anything that God has called you to finish that you've left undone?
