## SERMON DISCUSSION GUIDE

## I Kings 7:1-12

## Ice Breaker: What is your favorite home you've lived in and why?

## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:**

- 1. **Recap:** Take a few minutes to recall what has happened so far in I Kings? What happened in the passage immediately prior to our passage?
- 2. Compare and contrast Solomon's choices in building the temple and the building of his palace.
- 3. The author does not tell us how to interpret Solomon's choices, but does the author give us any clues to understanding Solomon's heart in the process? Why or why not?
- 4. Solomon's home showed off his wealth and power. What are the characteristics of Christian homes ought to embody to guests? Give an example of a household that gives off the aroma of Christ? (2 Cor. 2:15) What makes this home a welcoming home?
- 5. What are things we are tempted to put too much value on in our homes? How does Jesus call us use our homes for his glory and not our own?
- 6. What are some strategies God gives us to stay content with what we have, rather than comparing ourselves to everyone around us?
- 7. Take some time as a group to give thanks to God for what he has given you both materially and spiritually.
