SERMON DISCUSSION GUIDE

Ruth 4

Ice Breaker: What's an evidence of God's grace you've seen this week? Ice Breaker: Share a story where you've recovered something that was lost.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

- 1. **Context:** Where does passage fall within the book of Ruth? What do we know about the main characters leading up to this story?
- 2. Context: Where does this story fall in grand narrative of Scripture?
- 3. What does it mean to redeem something? What did it mean for the people of Israel and their redemptive history?
- 4. What was the function of a "redeemer" mentioned on our text? What was the purpose of this institution? (see Deut. 25:5-10)
- 5. Why do you think the "nearer" redeemer (3:12) refused to redeem Ruth and the land?
- 6. What is the significance of Boaz' redemption of Ruth, for Ruth & Naomi personally and for what it says about the family of God?
- 7. How does this story of redemption connect to Jesus' redemption of us? Why does the author of Ruth conclude this narrative with a genealogy?
- 8. What do Christians mean when we say & sing that we've been redeemed by the blood of Jesus? (Eph. 1:7)
- 9. How should the truth of our redemption change the way we live? In what ways do we still live like an unredeemed people?
