

SERMON APPLICATION GUIDE

Psalm 110

Ice Breaker: What's an evidence of God's grace you've seen this week?

Ice Breaker: What one household item could you not live without and why?

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

1. What is a Messianic Psalm? Can you think of any others?
2. **Read:** Psalm 110. What are your first impressions of it? What is the structure of the Psalm?
3. It's said that Psalm 110 may be the most important Psalm. What would you expect to find in the most important Psalm? What do we actually find in Psalm 110?
4. What does it mean that Jesus has all authority on earth? What, then, can we expect from him in the future? How does this give us hope?
5. Does Jesus' authority extend into your life? How much authority are you willing to give him? What areas of life are you struggling to surrender to Jesus?
6. If Jesus has all authority on earth, what impact does this have on our obedience? What barriers do you have in your heart to obeying Jesus no matter the earthly cost?
7. Have you heard of Melchizedek before? How does Genesis 14 help us understand Psalm 110. How does Hebrews 7 and 8 apply to Jesus' priesthood?
8. How does Jesus' priestly sacrifice on the cross apply to us? Do you feel secure in Jesus because he has saved you from your sins? How can Jesus bring you comfort, encouragement, and strength?
9. How can Jesus' kingship and priestly office encourage you to trust in Jesus this week? What areas in your life is is hard to trust in Jesus?
