Luke 17:1-6

Ice Breaker: What's an evidence of God's grace you've seen this week? **Ice Breaker:** Is there anything about the Christian life that feels impossible?

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

- 1. Read Luke 17:1-6.
- 2. What is the weighty warning that Jesus gives in vs. 1-3a? Why do you think this warning is so severe? Who is this warning directed towards? What should our response be to this warning?
- 3. What are some common stumbling blocks that we find often in our culture that have caused many of fall into sin?
- 4. Why does Jesus call us to rebuke or correct a brother or sister who is in sin? What ought you to consider before going someone in rebuke? (Matt. 7:1-5).
- 5. Why is it difficult to fulfill this command of Scripture? How can you make yourself a person who welcomes correction from others?
- 6. What is surprising about Jesus' teaching about forgiveness? How does this contrast with our culture?
- 7. What does it mean to truly forgive someone and what makes forgiveness so difficult?
- 8. Why can we believe forgiveness is possible? What does Jesus teach that helps us to believe we can forgive?
- 9. What truths of the gospel do we need to remember as we walk in forgiveness towards others?
- 10. What are some ways you can foster church community where brothers and sisters graciously correct and forgive one another? How can you start this in your own home?
- 11. How can your small group foster the relationships Jesus talks about and help one another watch out for stumbling blocks?
