Luke 18:15-30

Ice Breaker: What's an evidence of God's grace you've seen this week? **Ice Breaker:** What is your favorite childhood game to play or story that was read to you?

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

- 1. Read Luke 18:15-30: What are your initial reactions to these two scenes? Anything surprising?
- 2. What does it mean for us to receive the kingdom like a child?
- 3. What hinders us today from coming to Jesus with a childlike faith and dependance? What cares of the world or beliefs in our heart cause us to think Jesus would not receive us?
- 4. Compare/contrast the way the children come to Jesus and how the ruler comes to Jesus.
- 5. What did the rich ruler presume about himself and his righteousness before coming to Jesus?
- 6. How does Jesus cut through the man's question and address his heart? What does the ruler's reaction say about what he loved?
- 7. What things do we love on our life that may keep us from being fully devoted to Jesus? How have you seen the love of money and possessions be a barrier that keeps people from coming to Jesus?
- 8. How does Jesus give encouragement to his disciples who have given up the cares of the world is worth it to gain Christ?
- 9. Share stories of people you know who have counted the cost to follow Jesus even at great personal expense.
