## SERMON APPLICATION GUIDE

Luke 20:27-44

Ice Breaker: What's an evidence of God's grace you've seen this week?

Ice Breaker: Share a favorite riddle with your group!

## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:**

- 1. Read Luke 20:27-40.
- 2. Context: Where are we at in the book of Like and who are the Sadducees who come to question Jesus? What are their distinguishing beliefs? (See Matt. 22:23)
- 3. What is the riddle they put before Jesus and what belief are they trying to trap Jesus in disproving? (See Duet 25:5-10)
- 4. What two-part answer does Jesus give them that silences the Sadducees? How does Jesus turn their question back at them when he refers to Exodus 3:6?
- 5. How does Jesus' answer also instruct us in how we ought to view marriage? How does it instruct us on how we ought to view the Scriptures?
- 6. How can we live our lives with the final resurrection more in view? How ought the hope of the resurrection change the way we live?
- 7. Read Luke 20:41-44. What is significant about Jesus' question to the Sadducees?
- 8. Why does it matter that the Messiah was to be both David's son and David's Lord? (see 2 Sam. 7:12-16 & Psalm 110).
- 9. The confession "Jesus is Lord" is something that Christians have held fast to through church history in the face of other so-called "lords." How does this confession clash with our culture today?
- 10. In what ways do we confess "Jesus is Lord" on Sundays but serve other "lords" throughout the week?

**Application:** Take time to pray as a group and ask the Holy Spirit for strength to walk faithfully in our confession.
