GO DEEPER

1. Read 1 John 4:7-12. What does this passage reveal to us about the nature of God's love? What does it suggest our response is with what we've been given?
2. Read John 13:1-17. How does Jesus illustrate giving His love and life to His disciples? What does He instruct them to do?
3. Read Matthew 5:14-16. According to this passage, what should our lives look like to others? What does the passage instruct us to do?

MAKE IT PERSONAL

1. If you believe in the Gospel, that it truly is **good news**, why does it not influence more of your life or your daily conversations? Why is it difficult to share what's been poured into us?
2. What are ways that we can look up and see the opportunities around us to bless others with the love and life that's been given to us?
3. What is one thing in regards to radical love and service that you desire to grow in today? How can others help walk with you in that next step?

PRACTICE IT NOW

Spend time as a group thanking God for the specific ways He has poured out His radical love to you and/or your families. Ask God to identify and restore any part of your heart that finds difficulty in loving and serving other people. Ask for and encourage each other in prayer for the heart of a servant and the ability to pour out the radical love that's been given to you by Jesus.
