



#3 "THE FEET OF WORSHIP"

1. Real worship is a walk of surrender.

Matthew 4:19-20 (NIV) "Come, follow me," Jesus said, "and I will send you out to fish for people." At once they left their nets and followed him.

Luke 9:23-26 (NIV) Then he said to them all: "Whoever wants to be my disciple must deny themselves and take up their cross daily and follow me. For whoever wants to save their life will lose it, but whoever loses their life for me will save it. What good is it for someone to gain the whole world, and yet lose or forfeit their very self? Whoever is ashamed of me and my words, the Son of Man will be ashamed of them when he comes in his glory and in the glory of the Father and of the holy angels."

Luke 14:11 (NIV) For all those who exalt themselves will be humbled, and those who humble themselves will be exalted.

James 4:10 (NIV) Humble yourselves before the Lord, and he will lift you up.

2. Real worship is a walk of faith and obedience.

To walk by faith means that you build your life around a deep belief in:

- ▶ The existence of God, revealed in His Son, Jesus Christ.
- ▶ The integrity of God.
- ▶ The power of God.
- ▶ The commands and principles of God.
- ▶ The promises of God.
- ▶ The prevailing nature of God.

James 2:26 (GW) A body that doesn't breathe is dead. In the same way faith that does nothing is dead.

Ephesians 5:8 (TPT) Once your life was full of sin's darkness, but now you have the very light of our Lord shining through you because of your union with him. Your mission is to live as children flooded with his revelation-light!

Ephesians 5:15, 16 (TPT) So be very careful how you live, not being like those with no understanding, but live honorably with true wisdom, for we are living in evil times. Take full advantage of every day as you spend your life for his purposes.
