1. _____ the difference between _____ worship and _____ worship.

Psalms 51:16-17 (NIV) You do not delight in sacrifice, or I would bring it; you do not take pleasure in burnt offerings. My sacrifice, O God, is a broken spirit; a broken and contrite heart you, God, will not despise.

John 4:23-24 (NIV) Yet a time is coming and has now come when the true worshipers will worship the Father in the Spirit and in truth, for they are the kind of worshipers the Father seeks. God is spirit, and his worshipers must worship in the Spirit and in truth.

2. Give God your _____.

Psalms 9:10 (NIV) Those who know your name trust in you, for you, LORD, have never forsaken those who seek you.

Psalms 20:7 (NIV) Some trust in chariots and some in horses, but we trust in the name of the LORD our God.

Psalms 52:8 (NIV) But I am like an olive tree flourishing in the house of God; I trust in God's unfailing love for ever and ever.

Psalms 62:8 (NIV) Trust in him at all times, you people; pour out your hearts to him, for God is our refuge.

Proverbs 3:5-6 (NIV) Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight.

In the Old Testament, there are seven Hebrew words for praise. David practiced them all!:

1. Hallel.

Psalms 18:3 (NIV) I called to the LORD, who is worthy of praise, and I have been saved from my enemies.

2. **Yadah.**

Psalm 107:15 (NLT) Let them praise the LORD for his great love and for the wonderful things he has done for them.

3. **Todah.**

Psalm 100:4 (NIV) Enter his gates with thanksgiving and his courts with praise; give thanks to him and praise his name.

4. **Shabach.**

Psalm 63:3 (NKJV) Because Your lovingkindness is better than life, My lips shall praise You.

5. **Barach.**

Psalm 96:12 (NIV) Let the fields be jubilant, and everything in them; let all the trees of the forest sing for joy.

6. **Zamar.**

Psalm 57:9 (NIV) I will praise you, Lord, among the nations; I will sing of you among the peoples.

7. **Tehilah.**

Psalm 22:3 (NIV) Yet you are enthroned as the Holy One; you are the one Israel praises.

Psalm 34:1 (NKJV) I will bless the Lord at all times; His praise shall continually be in my mouth.

Psalm 119:164 (NIV) Seven times a day I praise you for your righteous laws.
