

1. REVIEW THE SERMON

READ Acts 17:24-29: Paul knows idols can't just be run from, the worship of our heart must be replaced with a right view of the One, True God. A big view of God roots out idols. When have you been overwhelmed by God as Creator?

When have you seen the power of God as Sustainer?

What comfort should we take knowing our God is Sovereign King?

READ ACTS 17:30-31: Paul preaches urgency to repent. Why is there urgency to repent of worshipping false gods? Why don't we often feel that urgency? What does it look like to share Christ with people with a loving urgency that longs to see them repent?

READ ACTS 17:32-34: Of all the cities Paul has preached Christ in, what sticks out about how it says the people of Athens respond to this message? What does the fact that only "some" joined him say about the effect idols have on responding to the truth of Jesus?

2. ASSESS YOUR HEART

What idols have you identified in your heart this week that needs to be displaced with a heart full of awe and worship at the one true God?

3. APPLY THE TRUTH

What can you do this week to ignite the awe of God in such a way that your heart is full of worship to Him?

GROUP COMMITMENTS

SERMON NOTES

- 1) The heart is an **idol factory**, and this should **grieve** us. (v. 16)
- 2) The worship of **idols** reveals our deeper longing to worship **God**. (vs. 17-23)
- 3) God is the only one **worthy** of our worship. (vs. 24-29)
- 4) If we have been **worshipping** idols, we repent and turn to worship **God**. (vs. 30-34)
