1. REVIEW THE SERMON

Read Acts 22:1-16. Why is it important to be able to share your testimony with others? Why are personal testimonies of faith in Christ so powerful? (See 1 Peter 3:15)

Read Acts 23:1-11. How does knowing God is with us during trials or when our faith is being tested help us to stand firm?

Read Acts 26:22-29. Why is it especially important to witness to the gospel of Jesus when life is hard and our faith is on trial? How does continuing to witness in the midst of difficult seasons give our words and testimony more power?

2. ASSESS YOUR HEART

Do you find it easy to share your testimony—even in difficult seasons? What keeps you from sharing your testimony in both good and difficult seasons?

3. APPLY THE TRUTH

How is God calling you to stand bold for him this week? What is an area of life where you need to take a stand for Christ?

4. I AM SENT... THIS WEEK

Who is someone in your circle of influence who needs to hear your testimony of faith in Christ this week?
