

1. REVIEW THE SERMON

Read Matthew 4:18-22. Why is it significant that Jesus chose these men to be his followers? How does Jesus calling of the disciples provide encouragement for the rest of us? (See 1 Cor. 1:26-31)

In what way is Jesus' call to "follow me" an invitation to become increasingly like him? What are some tools or avenues we have that lead us to hear from Jesus?

Place yourself in the disciples' shoes for a moment. How do you think you would have responded to Jesus call? In what ways did the disciples model radical obedience?

How is Jesus' call to follow him directly connected to the mission of making disciples of all nations?

2. ASSESS YOUR HEART

Following Jesus is about the pattern of our lives. What patterns do you have in your life that enable you to hear from Jesus on a consistent basis?

3. APPLY THE TRUTH

The call to be a follower of Jesus is also a call to be a fisher of men. What step(s) can you take this week to live out Jesus' invitation to "follow me and I will make you fishers of men."
