

SERMON APPLICATION GUIDE

Walking By Faith
GENESIS 12

Walking by faith happens one step at a time.

1. REVIEW

Tell the story of a trip or project that you had to start before you were certain how it would end.

Read Genesis 12:1-10 aloud. God didn't give Abram details about the destination, but God did give him promises. List the promises God gave Abram. Why do you think He didn't give him more detail?

Why do we still want clarity and certainty in the destination (and frankly, in every detail of the journey) when God has given us clarity and certainty in who He is?

2. ASSESS

Where is God calling you to leave what you know and walk out into the unknown? What will you have to give up to get there?

Think backward. What faith-building famines in your life have allowed you to learn God more, lean on God more and / or love God more? How will that get you through any fear in your next step?

When we don't understand the path or know the destination, we must trust the one who calls us forward. What do you know about the character of God that will help you trust Him? (Use scripture to support your answer.)

3. APPLY

Write out the step of faith you must take **this week**:
