A HIGH CALL TO CHRIST'S SERVANTS | 1 Timothy 4:6-16

「WORSHIP」

How can your discipleship group start with **worship** today?

「WALK」

Spend time **understanding** and **applying** God's Word.

1. REVIEW + UNDERSTAND

What stuck out as most interesting or most impactful from the Sunday morning worship gathering?

Read 1 Timothy 4:6-16. Why do you think Paul instructs Timothy in both doctrine and discipline? What is the connection between the two? How tightly would you say those are connected in your own life? Give examples.

How much of your training has been self-guided? How much have you learned from others? Share a story of each.

What role and responsibility do you have in bringing about your own spiritual maturity? What role does God have in our spiritual maturing? Evaluate the interaction between the two.

2. ASSESS + APPLY

Consider your mental "diet." What sources of information do you consume regularly? How does that "diet" prepare your heart and mind for training in godliness?

When was the last time you broke a spiritual sweat? Are you spiritually out of shape or spiritually fit for the race ahead?

What is your plan for training in godliness? If you have a good one, humbly share to encourage others. If you don't, humbly ask for help and accountability.

Are you living an exemplary life (considering the list in verse 12)? Devote yourself to all these things through prayer and accountability with other believers now.
