THE GREATNESS OF GOD (PT.2) | Genesis 3:16 - 4:31

WORSHIP

How can your discipleship group start with **worship** today?

WALK

Spend time **understanding** and **applying** God's Word.

1. REVIEW + UNDERSTAND

We are spending nearly an entire year focusing on the question: "Who is God?" Why is this important? What have you learned so far?

Read Exodus 4:11-12. Now read 2 Corinthians 12:9. What can we learn about God from His response to Moses concerning his slow speech?

Aaron is on his way to Moses before Moses ever makes the excuse regarding his slow speech. This observation means that either: A) God knew and prompted Aaron before the conversation with Moses. or B) God used an action already in process to accomplish his purposes. Which of those do you think is more likely? Do you think it matters which one?

Which of the characteristics of God brought out in this passage was most compelling, convicting, or comforting to you? Why?

2. ASSESS + APPLY

God's sovereignty is often emphasized when we feel things are going wrong. "Well, I guess God is sovereign." But God is equally sovereign when things are going well (when we are more likely to imagine things are under our control.) Why do you think we primarily focus on God's sovereignty when things aren't great?

The plunder from the Egyptians is eventually used in two ways: one is the Tabernacle and the other is the golden calf. What are somethings in your own life that are both a blessing from a sovereign God and a possible temptation? What safeguards have you put in place to guard against this temptation?

Throughout this passage we've watched Moses give excuse after excuse until he finally asks God to send someone else. What excuses are you making instead of obeying what you know God has gifted you and called you to do?
