## WORSHIP

How can your discipleship group start with worship today?

## WALK

Spend time understanding and applying God's Word.

### 1. REVIEW + UNDERSTAND

#### **GOD IS FAITHFUL TO HIS PROMISES EVEN IN THE FACE OF OUR UNFAITHFULNESS.**

1. Read Romans 9:4-5. What kinds of things come to Paul's mind when he thinks about the advantages of being a Jew? What does he single out in Romans 3?
2. How does our unfaithfulness show the faithfulness of God? How does our unrighteousness show the righteousness of God?
3. If it's a gospel of grace, why not keep sinning so God's grace is made glorious all the more? Their condemnation is just. What do you understand about the objections and answers here? What would you like to study more? How do these lead you to worship?

### 2. ASSESS + APPLY

1. While growing up in a church community does not make us right with God, what are some advantages it does provide?
2. What are some personal ways God has been faithful in our own unfaithfulness?
3. What is my understanding of my own accountability before God? Have I been brought to a place where I stop talking, stop making excuses and plans to do better, and begin to rely on the righteousness of God through faith in Jesus?
