WORSHIP

WALK

Spend time understanding and applying God's Word.

1. REVIEW + UNDERSTAND

THE GOSPEL PRODUCES HUMILITY, UNITY, AND LIVES LIVED RIGHTEOUSLY.

1. What kind of boasting is Paul addressing in this passage. How does the gospel exclude this kind of boasting?
2. Read 1 Corinthians 1:26-31, Galatians 6:14, and 2 Corinthians 12:9-10. As followers of Christ, what should we boast in? How does this kind of boasting elevate the gospel in our lives?
3. Where in your life do you sense any of the 3 wrong boasts of how we are made right with God?

2. ASSESS + APPLY

1. Read Philippians 3:7-9. What would be on my list of boastings? Whatever that list might contain, however it would have previously been used to boost my ego or buoy my identity, can I say with Paul that I now count those things as loss when compared to knowing Jesus?
2. Read Matthew 5:16. What would it mean to let my light shine, to do the good works God has prepared for me, in such a way that everyone around me would know, and that I would know in my heart, that the glory goes only and entirely to God?
