## WORSHIP

How can your discipleship group start with worship today?

## WALK

Spend time understanding and applying God's Word.

### 1. REVIEW + UNDERSTAND

#### **I AM A GREAT SINNER AND CHRIST IS A GREAT SAVIOR.**

1. What is the tone change that happens in this passage?
2. Why is it important to realize we are talking about a righteousness of God (about God, from God, relating to God)?
3. How is God's righteousness revealed in this passage?
4. How does the law and the prophets bear witness about this righteousness of God?
5. Where do you see God's patience, justice, and grace in this passage?

### 2. ASSESS + APPLY

1. We have heard Paul explain the good news of the gospel. What parts of the gospel are you still trying to understand better or wrap your mind around?
2. What does it mean that there is "no distinction" between those who, by faith in Jesus, have been given the gift of grace? How is this lived out in our own community?
3. This is a passage that we've heard on many occasions, and if you're a tenured Christian, there's a chance you didn't learn something new. Even still, how are you worshiping over these truths and where do you need to be "re-awed" by the Gospel?
