6.	Read Ephesians 5:2. How did Paul define and understand love in this passage? Why must a person know the work of Jesus' life, death, and resurrection to love?
7.	Read 1 John 4:7-21. What reasons do these verses give us for why we should practice godly love and what do they reveal about the way we are to relate to God and others in love?
8.	How does your patience and obedience to God affect your love for others?

9. What does your current level of patience with God communicate about the depth of your love for Him?
